En la actualidad nuestra institución se encuentra trabajando en una propuesta de **Modelo de Desarrollo Agroforestal en Comunidades Mapuche de la comuna de Carahue**, la que se espera financiar con aportes de FIA.

En su calidad de largo plazo quedan planteados una vez de contar con modelos de desarrollo agroforestal propios que nos permitan la generación de políticas y experiencias orientadas a adaptar los instrumentos legales existentes como el DL 701 de 1974 Ley de Fomento y producción Forestal y DL 235 de 1999 Incentivos para la Recuperación de Suelos Degradados, que podrían en su conjunto potenciar las actividades realizadas a través de la agroforestería.

Finalmente el desafío que nos presenta la Agroforestería y las tendencias mundiales en la que a ella se refieren nos entregan una clara orientación a fomentar la soberanía alimentaria de los pueblos y mantener y conservar la producción de agua, bajo sus diferentes técnicas de manejo de RRNN.

5. Aplicabilidad: explicar la situación actual del rubro en Chile (región), compararla con la tendencias y perspectivas en el país (región) visitado y explicar la posible incorporación de los conocimientos adquiridos, en el corto, mediano o largo plazo, los procesos de adaptación necesarios, las zonas potenciales y los apoyos tanto técnicos como financieros necesarios para hacer posible su incorporación en nuestro país (región).

En las comunidades Mapuche de las regiones VIII, IX y X, ha podido observar durante estas últimas décadas como el desarrollo de masa forestal, perteneciente principalmente a las empresas forestales y su modelo productivo, ha aumentado explosivamente y en algunos casos acorralando a estas en medio de extensas masas de plantaciones de especies exóticas, principalmente del género pinus y recientemente del género eucaliptos. Todo esto ha traído y presentado a la vida campesina la posibilidad de incorporar el componente forestal bajo un esquema similar al de las empresas, así se han formado pequeños bosques de plantaciones de baja calidad en manos de pequeños productores, esto sin lugar a dudas trae una disminución de las posibilidades de producción y diversificación en la economía campesina, lo cual ha contribuido en parte a aumentar la migración de muchos jóvenes del campo a la ciudad, fenómeno que esta en plena vigencia.

Este esquema del monocultivo ha sido promovido y desarrollado por las propias instituciones del estado como CONAF e INDAP como una alternativa productiva, la que sin lugar no es la más viable a la hora de hablar de seguridad alimentaria de las comunidades Mapuche.

Lo que se señala anteriormente hacen que la Agroforestería tome y alcance un real valor, puesto que como ya se ha indicado permite que, se genere producción en el corto plazo, se realice la protección de los RRNN y además de complementarse con la visión integradora y de respeto de la naturaleza propia de la cosmovisión Mapuche.

Es por esto que se hace urgente el poder iniciar el siguiente plan de trabajo de aquí a los próximos 10 años en los cuales se priorizan las siguientes etapas:

- Difusión y Educación Agroforestal (\$ 65,000,000)
- Implementación de Módulos Agroforestales Comunitarios (\$ 72,000,000)

Además de lo anterior nuestra institución se encuentra trabajando en la traducción de la información en Mapunzugun (Lengua Mapuche), al igual que la preparación de materiales de capacitación y de educación medioambiental, para lo cual se está preparando una propuesta de difusión masiva de la agroforestería, en pequeñas propiedades Mapuche.

Durante el desarrollo de las charlas de difusión planificadas observamos con gran satisfacción el grado de pertinencia cultural que posee la agroforestería, como técnica productiva de manejo de los RRNN, y el gran grado de entendimiento y sentido que lke hace para las comunidades y Familias mapuche cuando ven a través de videos e imágenes su cosmovisión integradora y totalizadora llevada a cabo en otros lugares del planeta.

Dentro de este contexto es que podemos señalar la importancia de iniciar en forma masiva un programa de educación medioambiental y productivo en las comunidades Mapuche, en la educación y promoción de estas técnicas, que sin lugar a dudas se convierte en el único paquete tecnológico que podría orientar la producción y conservación de los RRNN, asegurando así un recurso productivo para las nuevas generaciones.

De la misma forma y gracias a las experiencias compartidas con la gente participantes de las charlas nace la idea fuerza de formar la **Cooperativa Agroforestal Mapuche** como una propuesta de trabajo propio, autónomo, sustentable y pertinentemente cultural, dado el nivel de contactos y vínculos generados que podrían ser sumados a contribuir a esta gran propuesta de trabajo para los próximos 10 años.

Labor Implications and Profitability of Agroforestry versus Conventional Maize Production Systems in Southern Africa

While the biophysical feasibility of improved fallow has been long established, several socio-economic questions are being asked. These include: "What quantity of labor is required for agroforestry compared with conventional methods?" "What is the financial profitability of agroforestry compared to other methods?" and "How do macro policies affect the profitability of these technologies?" A detailed field study was carried out to respond to these questions. Results show that household members provide 90% of all farm labor inputs, thus making their health status a critical factor in farm production and security. Labor requirements for different technologies should be evaluated not only in terms of *absolute quantity* but also in terms of *temporal distribution* of labor during farm season. Over a five-year season, continuous maize (*Zea mays* L.) without fertilizer yields a discounted net profit of US\$130 ha⁻¹ while maize with fertilizer yields US\$499 ha⁻¹. The figures for *Gliricidia*, *Sesbania* and *Tephrosia* fallow are US\$269 ha⁻¹, US\$309 ha⁻¹ and US\$233 ha⁻¹, respectively. Different financial scenarios affect the financial attractiveness and potential adoptability of agroforestry even *when technical coefficients between inputs and outputs remain constant*. The price of maize, labor wage rate, discount rate, cost of fertilizer, and timeliness of delivery of inputs, exert the greatest influence on the profitability of different maize production systems. Policies aimed at protecting the environment generally increase the profitability of agroforestry options; however, high inflation, political uncertainty, and short-term policies aimed at addressing emergencies, generally decrease the profitability and potential adoptability of agroforestry.
